The Elizabeth education Foundation is a non-profit organization with the mission of enhancing the educational process and opportunities for all students, teachers, employees, parents and community members in the Elizabeth C-1 School District. To this end, we are offering two, \$500.00 scholarships to graduating seniors of either Elizabeth High School or Frontier High School. The scholarship will be in the form of a reimbursement for tuition at either a college or vocational school for the beginning of the student's second semester based on verification of enrollment. Redemption policies of this scholarship will be provided when awarded.

- ❖ Please include the question number for each answer.
- ❖ The essay, question number 5, must be submitted on a separate page.
- ❖ Please include your name, email, address and phone number on your application.
- ❖ Please indicate whether you are an EHS or FHS student.

Applications are due by 12:00 p.m. on February 16, 2017.

Elizabeth High School students, please turn your application into the counseling office. Frontier High School students, please turn your application into the main office. Awarded scholarships will be announce during the awards ceremony in May 2017.

Your application should include the following to be considered:

1. Have you already applied or been accepted to a college/vocational school? If so, please attach a copy of your acceptance letter/email.
2. What college major or trade are you considering at this time?
3. What about this field interests you and why? (100 words maximum)
4. The goals of the Elizabeth Education Foundation (EEF) are to encourage, support and to enhance both teachers and students of the Elizabeth C-1 School District. The personal characteristics we promote are caring about family, school and the community. The EEF believes these characteristics can come from any student regardless of GPA or athletic ability. In what ways have you donated your time, either inside or outside of the home? (100 words maximum) Please attach two (2) letters from people whom you have donated your time.
5. Essay Portion – Our teacher grants, STARS award banquet and these scholarships are all made possible through our fundraising efforts. One of our revenue stream comes from the use of Safeway and King Soopers reloadable gift cards. For every dollar loaded on these cards, we receive .05 or 5%. It's a very simple program to use, only one additional step at the store and provides thousands of dollars to our programs. Additional information can be found on our website, www.elizabethef.org. There are two different essay topics – you may choose to write about either one:
 - If you were a member of our board, how would you promote the reloadable gift card program to increase participation with parents, faculty and our community?
 - If you were a member of our board, how would you recruit volunteers for the EEF?
